Technology Policy

Please note that the SSUNS 2026 technology will vary by committee size and format. As SSUNS will run as a hybrid conference, the policies for GAs, ECOSOCs, Specialized Agencies, and Crisis committees will differ.

Double-Delegate General Assemblies (WHO & CCPCJ)

Technology will be permitted at all times during committee sessions:

- Slack is the primary platform for communication between the Dais and delegates, due to the size of the committees.
- Delegates may use laptops and personal devices both in-room and out-of-room.
- Delegates are expected to arrive fully prepared, with all research completed prior to the conference.
- During moderated caucuses, devices may only be used for note-passing via Slack, and delegates must maintain full attention on the speaker.

ECOSOCs and Specialized Agencies

Committees will operate in a tech-free format, except for online resolution writing:

- Notes must be passed physically; digital note-passing is not permitted.
- Laptops and personal devices must be put away during moderated caucuses, unless specific accommodations have been approved.
- Devices may be used only during unmoderated caucuses for drafting working papers or resolutions.
- Delegates should bring printed copies of their research to avoid reliance on devices during sessions.
- For Specialized Agencies, directives will be written by hand on paper.

Crises

Committees will be conducted entirely on paper.

- Delegates must use paper for all in-committee functions, including:
 - Passing notes to fellow delegates
 - Writing directives
 - Sending crisis notes to the backroom
- Delegates must use 8.5" x 11" notebooks or legal pads to ensure consistency.
- In line with SSUNS' sustainability commitment, notepads will not be provided.





- Delegates are expected to bring two notebooks or legal pads, as committees operate on a two-notepad system.
